


LINEAGE

Vid. Srikantham Nagendra Shastry was born on 10-7-1972 and belongs to the family of Chintalapalli Parampara, Which has the rare distinction of serving dynasties like Ganga, Hoysala, Vijayanagar, Bahamani and Mysore rulers, as court musicians, and also having 800 years of recorded history. Shastry's ancestors were the direct disciples of Saint Shri Thyagaraja & Mysore Sadashiva Rao. Shastry's heritage also goes up to the time of Sri Krishna Devaraya of Vijayanagara kingdom.

His great grandfather, and grand father Mysore Asthana Vid. Sangeetha Rathna Chintapalli Venkata Rao and Chintalapalli Ramachandra Rao were celebrated musicians in Karnataka Music. Nagendra Shastry's Mother Smt. Susheela is the daughter of Chintalapalli Ramachandra Rao. His father Shreekantham Dattatreya Shastry also hails from an orthodox family of Vedic Scholars and Somayajis. Nagendra's Father was also a disciple of Ghantasala Venkateshwara Rao, a legend in South Indian Film music. Shastry was initially trained for about a decade under his grandfather Chintalapalli Ramchandra Rao and later from his maternal uncle Vid. Chintalapalli Suryanarayana Rao and pursued higher studies in Music, under Vidwan Ambi Bhagwatar: Disciple of Vid Ariakudi Ramanuja Iyengar and Chembai Vaidyanatha Bhagavatar, as well as Guru of Vidushi Papa Chudamani.

Nagendra learnt Sangeetha Shastra and Sreevidya from Maha Mahopadhyaya Padmashree Dr. R. Satyanarayana of Mysore and Tala Prastharaa Shastra from Akella Mallikarjuna Sharma of Hyderabad and Laya Technique under Mrudanga Vidwan M. S. Ramaiah.

Expertise in rendering: Raga - Tana - Pallavi

He is an expert in rendering distinct and celebrated pallavis of Chintalapalli Parampara, has won appreaciation from scholars for his perfect rendering of pallavis set to 108 talas as well as 35, 175, 1008 talas and 16 Kales. It has been proved in the Sabhas like Karnataka Gana Kala parishat and D. Subbaramaiah Trust (Bangalore.) demonstrations.

Shodasha Kales were rendered by only a few musicians who lived about two centuries back. However Sri Nagendra is the only living and competent person in the present generation who can render shodasha kale which is Equivalent the great Simhanandana Tala.

Dashavidha Raga Navathi Kusuma Manjari - A rare musical wonder which contains toughest of the talas, The Panchamukhi & Shanmukhi Talas. After its inception by Sri Ajjada Adi Bhatla Narayana Dasu, Nagendra Shastry is the first person to perform it for the first of its kind with his troupe of Nine students after a gap of almost 100 years.

Unique Style in Rendering Javalis and giving lecture - Demonstrations:

He has more than 1000 rare and envied Javalis in his collection and he has distinct style and presentation of Javalis and the same were highly appreciated by veteran artists like Dr. T. R. Subramanyam, Karpagam Swaminathan, Dr. S. R. Janaki Raman, Dr. Pappu Venugopala Rao, M. S. Gopala Krishnan and others during his lecture demonstration and performance of Javalis at Annual Music Conference of Madras Music Academy at Chennai.

Being an orator, has exhibited his versatility in lecture demonstrations, Speeches, Commentaries, Key Note & Valedictory Addresses apart from Gamaka Vachana, Halagannada Kavya and Vyakarana treatises, he has been complimented by reknowned music and art critics Shri S. N. Chandrasekhar and B. V. K. Shastry as an encyclopedia of Javalis and also in musical theory and history.

He has given a number of lecture demonstrations on rare ragas, Talas, Krithis, Composers, Srividya, usage of Tantra in music, Mantra and Tantra and other subjects apart from participating along with Dr Shatavadhani Ganesh in Avadhana performances also. Several musicians and dancers have learnt javalis from Nagendra and benefited from same and are exhibiting javalis in their performances.


